Financial Estimate of Cost of Season: \$1800 +

Each team's financial cost for a season varies based on their specific needs and size.

INSURANCE: \$250 to \$450

The estimated cost of team insurance ranges from \$250 to \$450, depending on the carrier and the coverage chosen. – If you are an existing recreation League, check you probably have insurance already. Most do.

UNIFORMS: \$234 - \$400

As low as \$26.10 through U.S Sports Apparel (\$234 - \$400 depending on team size). Uniforms must have Legion Lady's Fastpitch Logo on them.

Umpire Costs - \$800 - \$1000

For a season of 10-12 games, the estimated cost per umpire is \$80. The total cost will be between \$800 - \$1000, depending on the number of games played and the final cost set by officials.

Field Rentals -

If you don't have a field available, you will need to find one to use or rent. Many towns and cities have agreements with their local youth softball leagues. You can check with your town or city's department to learn about how to rent a field and the associated costs. Keep in mind that games played under lights will cost significantly more than unlit games.
